With a population of more than 39 million, the largest economy of any state (\$3.2 trillion gross state product (GSP), producing half of all the U. S. agricultural products, including 90% of all the wine, and with 35 Representatives out of 435 in the U. S. House, California is the economic and political powerhouse of America.

If California was a country, it would be far richer than most of the countries around the world, ranking 5<sup>th</sup> globally. Divided into Northern & Southern California, it has islands, mountains, valleys and deserts, all with varying climates, natural wonders including world's tallest trees (Redwoods) and the most massive tree with a trunk slightly greater than 102 feet in circumference. The 'General Sherman' in Sequoia National Park is the largest living tree (by volume) in the world. It is estimated to be somewhere between 1,800 to 2,700 years old. Southern California has about 10,000 earthquakes each year, although only 15 to 20 of them have a magnitude greater than 4.0.

The state is also home to hundreds of Multinational Corporation, banks, insurance companies, manufacturers and world-famous cultural institutions and national parks including: Hollywood, Disneyland, Yosemite National Park, Alcatraz, Angel Island and the Golden Gate Bridge.

Besides all the glory, political & economic strength, California has a very dark past with state sponsored killings of thousands of Native Americans by Governor Peter Hardenman Burnett, the state's first governor, even rewarding Gold Rush Settlers to killing Native men, women & children, enslaving them and taking over their properties. California finally apologized for the genocide in 2019.

Hundreds of peaceful Indian Tribes inhabited California for centuries before welcoming the European explorers (1542–1769), the Spanish(1769–1821), the Mexicans(1821–1848), and the United States (September 9, 1850–present). Nearly 80 per cent of all the Natives were killed or died of diseases & malnutrition within 20 years of U. S. take-over. Despite all that, California now has the United States largest Native American population and is home to 109 Federally Recognized Tribes.

Unfortunately Natives were not the only one who were discriminated. The Chinese immigrants, up to 20,000 of them were forced to provide back-breaking labor during both frigid winters and blazing summers for the construction of the Transcontinental Railroad, with meager wages and inhumane living conditions. Hundreds died from explosions, landslides, accidents and disease. The **Chinese Exclusion Act** was a United States federal law signed by President Chester A. Arthur on May 6, 1882, prohibiting all immigration of Chinese laborers. Building on the 1875 Page Act, which banned Chinese women from immigrating to the United States, thus forcing Chinese workers to not have any family members.

The anti-Asian sentiment further exacerbated in California as early as 1913, when the state passed the California "Alien Land Law", targeting Japanese, Chinese, Indians, Filipinos, Koreans and all other Asian immigrant farmers in California who, some in California's massive agricultural industry, perceived as a threat. Seven years later the state barred anyone with Asian ancestry from buying farmland. Most were not even allowed to own a business or a house and were forced to remain 'transient'.

After Japan bombed Pearl Harbor and the United States declared war, then-President Franklin D Roosevelt's signed an order on February 19, 1942 for the arrest and internment of about 120,000 Japanese Americans to be held at 10 internment camps in California & other states, depriving the Japanese of their homes, businesses and civil liberties. A congressional commission in 1983 apologized and paid \$20,000 in reparation to each victim.

African-Americans had had difficulty in California during the First Government trying to bar them from California and have ever since continued to have un-easy relationship. Governor Gavin Newsom has recently set-up a 9-member task force to discuss the proposal for providing reparations to Black Americans. California has experienced several race-relation tragedies in the past.

Nevertheless, California has done a remarkable job of changing its history and implementing a number of laws and regulations to improve race relations. With the minorities becoming the new majority, according to the last census, the society has much greater assimilation, integration and tolerance. California is now the most Multicultural & Multilingual State in the Union.

Tourism is a major industry in California, supporting 1.18 million jobs statewide and direct travel-related spending in California of \$144.9 billion in 2019. California is the most visited state in the United States. The state's vast area is home to various vibrant cities, amusement parks, beaches and natural wonders that are popular among travelers from America and the rest of the world. Both Los Angeles and San Francisco are considered Gateway Cities, and are home to some of the most popular and recognizable tourist spots in the country. These include the Golden Gate Bridge, Disneyland, and Hollywood. Additionally, some of the national parks located in California are also significant tourist destinations. For example, Yosemite National Park in Northern California is well known for its tall mountains, valleys, and beautiful waterfalls.

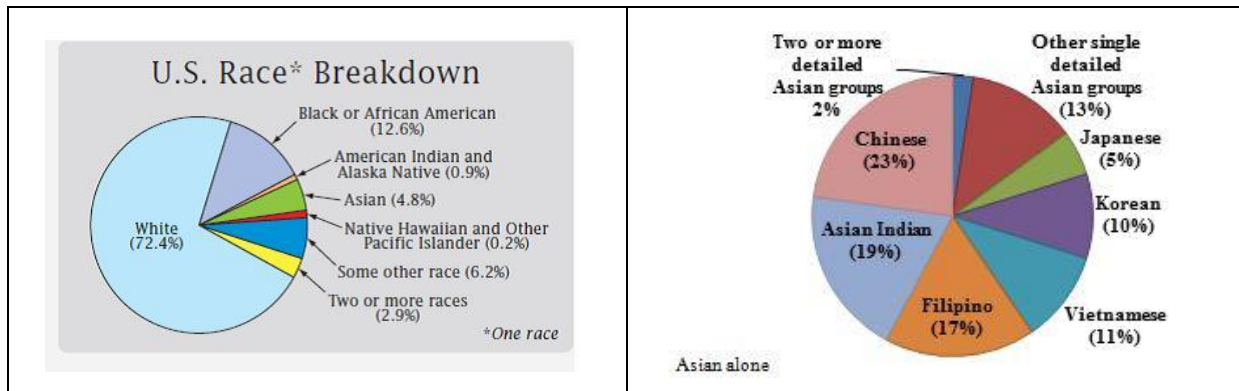

**Major Multicultural Population:** California has the highest total number of Hispanics of any U.S. State. They are also the largest single ethnic group in State. The other ethnic groups include Mexicans (25%), German (9%), Irish (7.7%), English (7.4%) and Italian (5.8%). There are 65 other ethnicities with sizeable populations in California, including Arabs, Albanians, Australians, Canadians, Haitians, Iranians and Somalians.

California has the largest population of European-Americans of any state, including Bulgarians, Romanians, Hungarians, Russians, Ukrainians, German, Irish, Italian, English, French, Polish, and Portuguese & Spanish.

## 2010 U.S. Census: A Profile of the Asian Population



While the total U.S. population grew by 9.7 percent to 308.7 million in 2010, the Asian population grew more than four times faster than any other racial group. The Asian alone population increased from 10.2 million in 2000 to 14.7 million in 2010, registering a 43 percent growth. Likewise, the Asian alone-or-in-combination population increased by 46 percent as it grew from 11.9 million in 2000 to 17.3 million in 2010.

The Asian population grew in all regions of the U.S. The alone-or-in-combination population grew the fastest in the South, boasting a 69 percent increase. This is followed by a 48 percent growth in the Midwest, a 45 percent growth in the Northeast, and a 36 percent growth in the West. While more Asians alone or in combination reside in the West, their overall proportion declined by three percentage points. Roughly 75 percent of the Asian population lives in ten states: California, New York, Texas, New Jersey, Hawaii, Illinois, Washington, Florida, Virginia, and Pennsylvania. Of these ten, Texas, Florida, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Washington, and New Jersey recorded the highest growth rates. Although the Asian population increased in all fifty states, it still represents less than 2 percent of the total population in West Virginia, Mississippi, Alabama, Kentucky, Arkansas, South Carolina, Tennessee, Louisiana, Montana, Wyoming, Idaho, South Dakota, North Dakota, Maine, and Vermont.

Asian subgroups also experienced growth. The Chinese alone-or-in-combination population is the largest detailed Asian group with a population of four million. While the Bhutanese population remains proportionally smaller than that of other detailed Asian groups, it recorded the fastest growth, increasing from 200 in 2000 to 19,000 in 2010. Asian Indians recorded the largest growth with a 68 percent increase from 2000. Filipinos followed with a 44 percent increase; the Vietnamese, 42 percent; Koreans, 39 percent. The Japanese recorded the slowest growth at 14 percent. Together, the Asian Indians, Chinese, and Filipinos form 60 percent of the Asian alone population.
