**Tourism Promotion** has become our special project during these uncertain times. Tourism is the world's largest industry. Prior to the pandemic, according to the National Travel and Tourism Week (NTTW) the travel industry was a powerful economic engine, supporting jobs and driving local economies in every pocket of America. The industry had experienced 107 straight months of growth, generated \$2.6 trillion in economic output, supported 17 million American jobs and delivered a \$51 billion trade surplus to the U.S.

In 2020, 12.6 million visitors spent \$3.4 billion in South Dakota. Pandemic affects results visitation declined 13%

and visitor spending dropped 18% as the pandemic affects travel...but losses have gotten smaller in South Dakota for 2020 and 2021.

While Tourism bounced back strongly in 2022, driven by pent-up demand and the lifting of travel restrictions, the international travel remains 54.6% below pre-pandemic. The recovery is fragile with new uncertainties from the economic slowdown & geopolitical instability.

The Multicultural Communities within South Dakota and throughout the world have always been instrumental in increasing Tourism Revenues for South Dakota, for employment and our economic growth. Let's work together to help each other.
